## Just Who Am I Dealing with Here?

*And 'don't sin by letting anger gain control over you.' Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, 27 for anger gives a mighty foothold to the Devil.*


Ephesians 4:26-27 (NLT)

Have you ever been angry and let the world know it? Perhaps a conversation isn't going the way you want and so you gruffly (that's putting it mildly) say "Good-bye" and flip the cell-phone closed and pitch it onto the floor. Or, at the end of a frustrating day at school, you'll gun the gas on your truck, glass-packs growling in a passive-aggressive roar letting everyone know you are mad. You slam a locker, or bite someone's head off. When asked, "What's wrong with you?" You angrily say, "Reggie makes me so mad!"

OK. Maybe you've never had anyone do anything to anger you, but I have. But then, it hit me not too long ago that in all reality, the real person I'm dealing with is not the person who did something to anger me, but myself. You see, I cannot control other people's actions, but I can control mine. I cannot control whether or not someone is angry with me because of something I did or something that I've been wrongly accused of doing. I cannot control other peoples' unrealistic expectations. I can't preach a sermon that EVERYONE will like or write a bulletin article that EVERYONE will enjoy. But when criticized for any of these things, I can control how I respond. I once heard someone say, "It's my job to treat you like a human being whether you act like one or not." That's exactly what I'm talking about.

So, when someone does something to anger you, deal with yourself first. "Don't sin by letting anger gain control over you" Paul told the Christians at Ephesus. Once you deal with yourself, you'll be in a better frame of mind to deal with the one who has made you angry.

Jesus loves you and so do I!

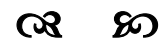
